As part of our “On-Call” service contract with the University, Pinnacle Energy Services provided commissioning on the Science-D Building serving undergraduate and graduate level chemistry and biology students.



Our recent work included commissioning of the Phase 7A work that is part of an overall effort aimed at remodeling the complete building with state-of-the-art laboratory spaces.

Pinnacle has and continues to provide extremely close project coordination with the University's Facilities Department as well their selected construction management firm on this highly-phased project that has successfully sequenced work to ensure classes maintain their normally scheduled sessions.

The overall project includes approximately 50,000sf of class and laboratory spaces including a mix of independent and manifold high-efficiency / low-flow fume hoods served by a pressure-controlled EA system equipped with an energy recovery coil.
